**REVISED OPENING HOURS** We are delighted to be able to open the Cathedral for more hours from next Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> October. The new hours will be as follows:

We will still have stewards for Mass times, and cleaning will be done with a fogging machine twice a day when the Cathedral is closed.

From this weekend a QR code will be available for people to 'sign-in' on entry to the Cathedral, which links to the Government 'Test and Trace' system.

Attendance at Sunday Masses and one off events will still need to be **pre-booked**, but not for weekday Mass.

**COMING INTO THE CATHEDRAL** To enable the social distancing rules to be followed, groups (except those in one household) must not gather inside the building.

Entry to the Cathedral will be through the North Door (facing London Road under the tower) and exit via the West Door. Please help our stewards by observing this system.

Please sanitise your hands on entry with the gel provided, observe the distancing rules and follow the one-way system.

**FACE COVERINGS** It is mandatory to wear a face covering in church unless you fall under the exempt categories. A covering may be a mask, shield or scarf, whatever is most comfortable.

**COMMUNION** A reminder that the current regulations from the Bishops Conference state that communion should be given in the hand only.

**MASS BOOKING** Please let us know which Sunday Mass (Saturday 6pm, Sunday 9.15am & 11.15am) you intend to attend by a Friday lunchtime. If you have already completed a form and there is no change, we will keep you on the list.
